> I'm writing to state my serious concern & opposition to a proposed AT&T cell tower on the water tank at the top of Alta Vista Road in Montara.  
>  
> I live within feet of the proposed location. It is by now well document that cell towers increase rates of cancer and negatively impact human, animal & environmental health, in some cases severely.  
>  
> There are several other homes in Alta Vista that are also way too close to the water tank location to escape the adverse effects of the cell tower radiation.  
>  
> In addition, the proposed location sits at the entrance to a popular hiking trail used daily by locals & visitors, with families & pets. All would be affected by the radiation.  
>  
> Montara mountain is specially rich in insect & bird life, with bees, butterflies, giant moths, beetles & many bird species of all sizes. There are also rabbits, frogs, lizards & snakes. There are local plants & insects found on this mountain that do not exist elsewhere! Wildlife will suffer, perhaps irreparably, from the high radiation of a cell tower.

> Let's protect our health & the beautiful & unique open spaces left in the Bay Area. Let's keep natural spaces clean of unnatural, manmade radiation. There are certainly more appropriate locations for this tower.
