Example #1: (2 Bedroom unit)

Housing Authority maximum subsidy: \$1,688

The Contract Rent = \$2,400 (the rent that the owner is requesting)

To figure out your rent,

- \$2,400 (Contract Rent)
- \$1,688 (HA Maximum Subsidy) **\$ 712 (Your portion)**

<u>In this example</u>: Your Portion = \$712 Housing Authority Portion = \$1,688

Example #2: (2 Bedroom unit)

Housing Authority maximum subsidy: \$1,688

The Contract Rent = \$1,600

To figure out your rent,

\$1,600 (Contract Rent)

- \$1,688 (HA Maximum Subsidy)

(-) \$88 \leftarrow Because the Contract Rent is *less than* the Maximum subsidy from the HA, then you would be responsible to pay the <u>\$100 minimum rent</u>.

<u>In this example</u>: Your Portion = \$100 Housing Authority Portion = \$1,500

Example #3: (1 Bedroom unit)

Housing Authority maximum subsidy: \$1,195

The Contract Rent = \$1,250

To figure out your rent,

\$1,250 (Contract Rent)

- \$1,195 (HA Maximum Subsidy)

\$ 55 \leftarrow Because the difference between the contract rent and the HA maximum subsidy is *less than* \$100, you would be responsible to pay the \$100 minimum rent.

<u>In this example</u>: Your Portion = \$100 Housing Authority Portion = \$1,150
