I hope this email finds you well. I wanted to check in with you following the updated Bay Area Stay-at-Home order that was issued yesterday. The updated order states that most residential and commercial construction is prohibited, while section f(v) lists construction-related exceptions to this order. Based on the latest guidance, will you be issuing a stop work order to the Highland Estates Project? Please let me know the path forward so we can plan accordingly.

Also, on a related note, how will the County be handling permitting projects at this time? We have a few clients that have requested Biological Reports for residential developments within the County; however, I assume site visits to support permitting would also be prohibited? Please let me know the County's take on this.
